Turn your FEAR into certain HOPE.

Fear...there's a lot of it about these days. Who can blame anyone of whom it might be said "...and it was heard in that he (you) feared."

Though you fear, **your** future can be <u>certain</u>! There is a verse in the Bible that points you to the certain path which gives you the peace that you crave for in your fear of the future.

I Tim 6:17. Charge them...in this world, that they trust...in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy; (kjv).

Instruct those...in this present world to fix their hope on God...who richly supplies us with all things to enjoy. (nasu).

We are already under sin! Because the Bible says "ALL have sinned and come short of the glory of God". (Romans 3:23) and why should we not believe it? the same chapter also says in v9 "ALL under sin".

King David (of Old Testament times) wrote in Psalm 14:1-3, The fool hath said in his heart, There is no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that doeth good. The Lord looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, and seek God. They are all gone aside, they are all together become filthy: there is none that doeth good, no, not one.

BUT you may say "I don't believe in the Bible, or God!!" That of course is your choice. Before you leave reading this article, because your eternal future is at stake, consider Romans 15:4, because it says: For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope. YES, that our fear might be turned to hope. I refer you to 1 Timothy 6:17 again that instructs us to trust in the Living God.

Do you not know that because we fall short of Gods glory (His Righteous standard) we have a price on our heads. We shall **ALL** appear before God to give account of our lives lived on this earth (2 Corinthians 5:10).

God has promised us eternal life (the certain future). The Bible says in John 3:16, For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. And again in Titus 2:14 Who (Jesus) gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity...(iniquity: breaking the law of God, i.e. unrighteousness). or If you like that He might redeem us from sin.

Dear friend, banish this fear you have of uncertain day, ahead by trusting in Gods only begotten Son, who gave himself to redeem us (buy us back). The bible says of Him (Jesus), in

Heb 1:3 - Who...by himself purged (washed off, cleansed) us of our sins,...

How did He do this?... by going to the cross of Calvary and there being crucified. The Bible says in 1 Cor 15:3-4 For I (the Apaostil Paul) delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, (from Jesus) how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; and that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:

Finally the certain days ahead of which I speak, is this: Eternal life is in the offering. whether you get "bitten"- overcome by this virus or not, your future is <u>certain</u>.

One final question you say, What must I do to be saved? The answer is straight forward and is found in the pages of the Holy Scriptures, for the Bible says..."Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved". Acts 16:31 Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved,

To be saved from what? The judgment of God. How? Eph 1:5,7: Having foreordained us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of His (Gods) will,...In whom we have redemption (to be bought back) through his blood, (His, Jesus crucifixion) the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his (Gods) grace;

This is the sum of what we have considered; Rom 10:9-10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation, (deliverance from sin).

And in John 6:37. Jesus said...him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out. (kjv). To believe in Him, to trust in Him for eternal life, He will NOT reject you.
